Code of Conduct: - Members

Bradford & Bingley Canoe Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Chair or any committee member.

As a member of Bradford and Bingley Canoe Club you are expected to abide by the following.

All members must play within the BCU rules and respect officials and their decisions.

All members will abide by the safety code of Bradford & Bingley Canoe Club.

All members must respect other paddlers and abide by paddling etiquette (eg. ensure eddies and gate lines are kept clear).

Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach if they are going to be late.

Members must wear safety equipment, appropriate to the conditions and their ability, as agreed with the coach/parent.

Members must inform the coach of any medical or other condition, which may affect their paddling ability.

Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.

Members are strongly discouraged from smoking or consuming alcohol on Bradford & Bingley Canoe Club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.

Members are not allowed to consume drugs (other than medicinal) on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

Members are encouraged to use correct and proper language at all times when taking part in club activities.
