Code of Conduct: - Club Officials & Coaches

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All officials & coaches are encouraged to:

Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance.

Develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust and respect.

Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part

Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play)

Display appropriate standards of behaviour and appearance

Use correct and proper language at all times when taking part in club activities.

Follow all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and the club

May be qualified by experience but are encouraged to hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and are further encouraged to regularly update their skills and knowledge

Must hold the relevant insurance cover as provided by BCU membership

Never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward

Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances.
